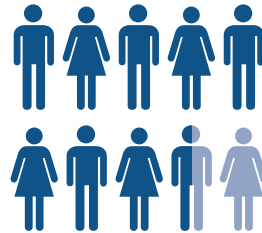
Addressing Non-communicable Diseases to Accelerate Universal Health Coverage in LMICs

>40 million

people die each year from lifestyle diseases such as diabetes and heart disease (non-communicable diseases - NCDs)



>85%

of these deaths occur in low- and middle-income countries



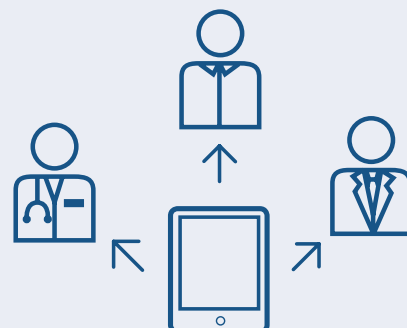
Achieving Universal Health Coverage is only possible if we properly address NCDs

to fight NCDs, especially in low- and middle-income countries

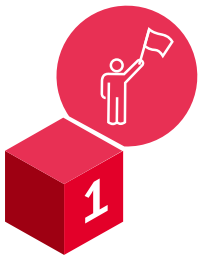

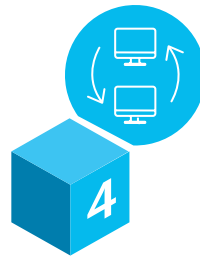
Policy makers need to prioritize and lead a national digital health strategy



Legal frameworks are essential to protect patients while enabling innovation



Standardized infrastructure that allows information to be used and shared is key to effective NCD management



Interoperability between diverse digital health solutions and data sources is a must to enable coordinated NCD management



Partnerships combine expertise, assets and ideas to amplify the scale and impact of successful digital health solutions

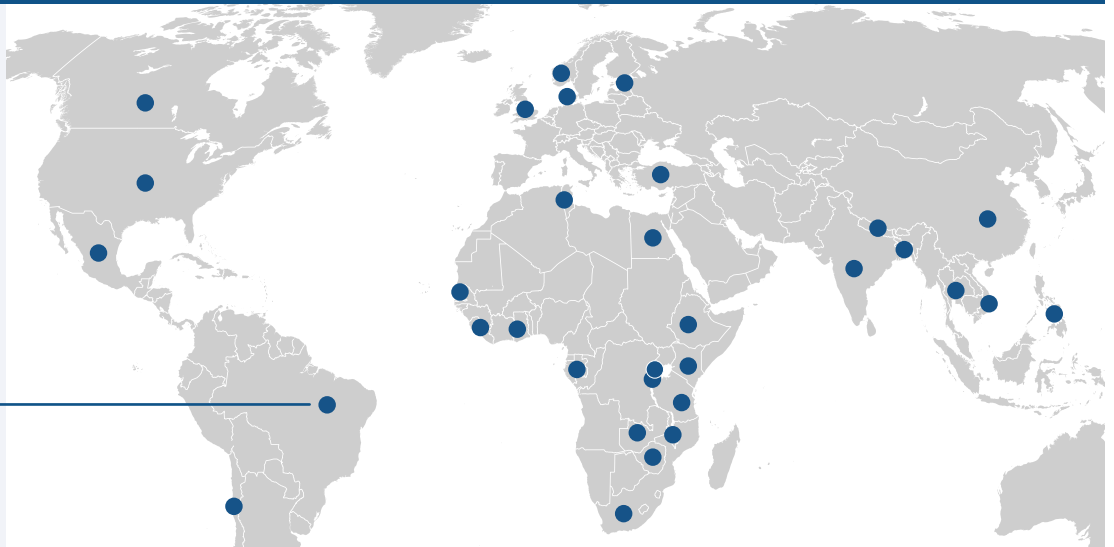


Sustained financing is mandatory if successful digital health solutions are to be scaled
