


# HealthTech Hub Africa

**Accelerating African health innovation through public-private collaboration**



### **Many promising African health technologies struggle to scale and integrate into public health systems.**

Launched in Kigali in partnership with the Norrskan Foundation, the HealthTech Hub Africa supported African startups developing solutions in cardiovascular

health, breast cancer, and virtual care. The hub combined acceleration, mentorship, investor matchmaking, and direct engagement with governments to fast-track adoption in health systems.



### **What changed?**

---

- Supported 30+ startups from across Africa in early cohorts
- Reached over 600,000 people through supported innovations
- Startups raised more than USD 10 million and created 300+ jobs
- Piloted public-sector innovation challenges with government partners

The hub reinforced the Foundation's belief that innovation, when aligned with public systems and policy, can deliver population-level impact.
